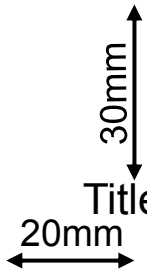

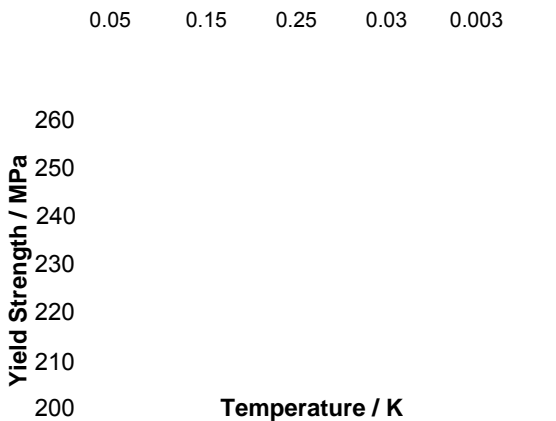


Fig.1 Influence of temperature
